The ReStore Volunteer Team, known as **ReTeam**, is made up of volunteers who want to do more than sign up for a shift from time to time; they want to strengthen the work of Habitat for Humanity through their commitment and involvement with the ReStore. ReTeam members choose from various volunteer roles that support ReStore and contribute at least two shifts every month.

Volunteer Opportunities Available:

Retail Volunteer

Work in a team environment to provide great customer service, receive donated materials, and help keep the stores looking great.

Product Specialist

A Retail Volunteer who has knowledge of building materials and the various applications to use them in, and works in a team environment to provide exceptional customer service by helping to answer customer questions with an experienced voice.

Foundation Volunteer

A Retail Volunteer who commits to at least one day per week, and gains knowledge to provide an exceptional ReStore experience for both customers and fellow volunteers.

Additional Opportunities:

- **ReStore Special Events Volunteer**

Occasionally we host special events at, or in benefit of our ReStores. As a ReStore Special Events Volunteer you are friendly, outgoing, and are familiar with the ReStores. Events may include pancake breakfasts, golf tournaments, information booths, etc.

- **Short Notice Volunteer**

At times we have a short notice volunteer request that usually involves physical work. As a Short Notice Volunteer you will be invited to help within a week's notice with anything from unloading a window truck, collecting a last minute donation or any of the tasks that can appear on short notice. Short Notice Volunteers choose the shifts suitable to them.

- **Upcycle Volunteer**

As an Upcycle Volunteer you will creatively repurpose items using materials from the Prefab Shop and ReStores. Finished items are sold at our ReStores to help fund programs. Volunteers are led by a supervisor, use power tools and finishing products to create masterpieces. No experience necessary!

What does it mean to be on the ReStore Volunteer Team?

- All team members commit to a minimum of two shifts per month
- All team members are invited to our bi-annual Volunteer Team meetings
- All team members receive a Volunteer Team T-Shirt after their first month
- All team members will be invited to participate in our Summer Event
