In 2010 the three Habitat Day pioneers, Christenson Developments, Landmark Group of Builders and Rohit Group of Companies, recognized how the Habitat program transformed families' lives. Families pay an interest-free mortgage that is never more than 25 percent of their income, and each payment they build equity in their home. The Habitat Day luncheon has since blossomed with 24 homes donated through the annual campaign – these homes help parents to provide a bright future for their children.

Habitat's home ownership program would not be possible without the support of dedicated donors and volunteers. The sustainable Habitat program is contingent upon forward-thinking community leaders and the participation of the community at large – including donors and volunteers. The builder partnership has been significant in helping Habitat Edmonton to become the largest affiliate in Canada.
